## Justice U.C. Dhyani (Oral)

By means of present claim petition, petitioner, *inter alia*, seeks to direct the respondent no.1 to decide his departmental appeal dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure: A-1).

2. According to the petition, petitioner is serving as O.S.D., Shri Badrinath Kedarnath Temple Committee (for short, BKTC). He was awarded

punishment of stoppage of increment with cumulative effect (major

Government, vide order dated 13.09.2023 of the Chairman, BKTC, Dehradun

(Respondent No.2).

3. Petitioner preferred departmental appeal to the Secretary

Religious Endowment, Govt. of Uttarakhand (Respondent No.1), on

13.10.2023. The same has not been decided so far.

4. The prayer of the petitioner, in present claim petition, is to

direct Respondent No.1 to decide departmental appeal dated 13.10.2023

(Annexure: A-1) of the petitioner. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submitted

that a direction be given to Respondent No.1 to decide the departmental appeal

at an early date. Ld. A.P.O. has no objection to such innocuous prayer of Ld.

Counsel for the petitioner. Ld. A.P.O. submitted that a direction may be given

to Respondent No.1 to decide the departmental appeal of the petitioner, as

per law.

5. Ld. Counsel for the parties submitted that such an order can be

passed by Single Bench of the Tribunal.

6. The claim petition is disposed of, at the admission stage, with

the consent of Ld. counsel for the parties, by directing Respondent No.1 to

decide the departmental appeal dated 13.10.2023 (Annexure: A-1) of the

petitioner by a reasoned and speaking order, as per law, without unreasonable

delay, preferably within 12 weeks of presentation of certified copy of this

order along with copy of appeal, enclosing the documents in support thereof.

No order as to costs.
