GENERAL NOTICE

The Claim Petitions under the U.P. Public Services (Tribunal) Act, 1976, relating to Nainital Jurisdiction [DB] shall be taken up and heard by the Division Bench comprising of Hon'ble Chairman and Hon'ble Vice Chairman(A), virtually, from Dehradun, from 10:15 A.M. onwards, and if need be, from 3:30 P.M. onwards, depending upon the convenience of the members of the Bar.

Claim Petitions relating to Dehradun jurisdiction [DB] shall be taken up and heard, virtually (optional), by the same Bench, upto 12:15 P.M. Those who are willing to address the Bench, physically, may do so, from 12:30 P.M. onwards [Dehradun jurisdiction].

Likewise, Appeals under the Real Estate (Regulation & Development) Act, 2016, shall be taken up and heard, virtually, by the aforesaid Bench, as per mutual convenience of Bar and Bench. Those who are interested in addressing the Bench, physically, may do so, from 2:30 P.M. onwards.

Single Bench matters relating to Dehradun jurisdiction shall be taken up and heard by Hon'ble Chairman at 11:30 A.M. virtually/physically as per mutual convenience of Bar and Bench

Single Bench matters relating to Nainital jurisdiction shall be taken up and heard by Hon'ble Vice Chairman (A) at 3:00 P.M. virtually from Dehradun.

Excerpts taken from Rule 35 of the Uttar Pradesh Public Services Tribunal Rules of Practice, 1997

(as applicable to Uttarakhand)

During the period of the Tribunal's vacations, the Vacation Judge shall sit on such days and transact such business of urgent priority and unavoidable nature, as the Chairman may specify. The Vacation Judge will be nominated by the Chairman.

During the vacation only those fresh matters which are required to be immediately or promptly dealt with shall, unless directed otherwise, be received in the Registry. The Registry, on being satisfied about the urgency order registration and posting of such cases.

During the vacation, the Registrar may accept CA/rejoinder/Review Petition, etc. in pending/ decided cases (RP) provided a copy of the same has been served on all the other parties/ legal practitioners.

Inspection of record or search may be permitted during vacation according to the rules.

Certified copies of judgements and orders may be supplied during the vacation according to rules.

Steps for issue of notice and for removal of defects in pending matters may also be taken during vacation.
