## Execution Petition No. 03/NB/DB/2021 Shrish Kumar

Present execution petition has been filed by the petitioner-executioner for securing the compliance of the judgment and order dated 24.12.2020, passed by this Tribunal in Claim Petition No. 34/NB/DB/2018, which is as follows:

"The claim petition is hereby allowed. The recommendation of the DPC dated 29.07.2016 about the petitioner, placing him in the unfit-category on the basis of the adverse entry of 2013-14 is hereby set aside.

The petitioner is also entitled for sanction and grant of pay scale of Rs. 15600-39100 with grade pay of Rs. 7600 like his juniors, w.e.f. 31.03.2014 alongwith its arrears and other benefits. Respondents are directed to allow such benefit to the petitioner within a period of four months from the date of production of copy of this order."

In the Writ Petition (S/B) No. 573 of 2021 filed by the State, Hon'ble High Court passed the following order, on 13.12.2021:-

"The petitioners are directed to comply with the order passed by the learned Tribunal within a period of two months from the date of the production of a certified copy of this order."

A compliance affidavit dated 21.04.2022 has been filed by Sri Shyam Singh, Joint Secretary, Personnel and Vigilance, Govt. of Uttarakhand, Dehradun, along with copy of Govt. Notification, to indicate that the petitioner has been granted Selection Grade pay scale of Rs. 15,600-39,100, Grade Pay of Rs. 7600, revised pay scale of Rs. 78800-209200 (Level-12 in 7<sup>th</sup> Pat Commission Matrix) *w.e.f.* 31.03.2014. It has also been indicated in the Notification that Sri Shrish Kumar, petitioner, shall be entitled to arrears and other service benefits *w.e.f.* 31.03.2014.

In this way, the order sought to be executed, has been complied with.

Learned A.P.O. submitted that the execution petition may kindly be closed, which proposal is agreed to by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

The execution petition is, therefore, closed for full satisfaction.
