This claim petition has been filed for the following reliefs:

(i) Issue an order or direction calling for the record and directing the respondents to grant promotion to the petitioner as a Junior Assistant under the disability G.Os' of the Union Govt. as well as State Govt. and as per Service Rules from the date of last selection for the post of Junior Assistant. (ii) Issue any suitable claim, order or direction which this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the

circumstances of the case.

(iii) Award the cost of claim petition in favour of the

petitioner.

2. Pleadings have been filed by both the sides. During the course of

arguments, learned Counsel for the petitioner restricted his prayer to the

extent that the letter dated 12.08.2022 sent by the Chairman of the

Uttarakhand Divyang Karmik Sangh to the Additional Chief Secretary to

Hon'ble C.M., Uttarakhand Govt. has requested to follow the roster adopted

by the U.P. Govt. for Persons with Disabilities who have reserved roster point

nos. 1, 26, 51 and 76 for Persons with Disabilities. On this letter, which has

been filed as Annexure no. 3 to the Supplementary R.A. of the petitioner, the

Additional Chief Secretary has desired a meeting on this issue and made an

endorsement to the Secretary, Karmik accordingly. Learned Counsel for the

petitioner submits that a decision on the same may be taken at the earliest

by the Govt. of Uttarakhand and if roster point no. 1 is reserved for the

Persons with Disabilities, then the petitioner's case can be considered in that

light.

3. Without prejudice to the rival contentions, the Tribunal feels it

appropriate and directs the respondent no. 1 to get a suitable decision taken

by the Govt. on the above referred letter dated 12.08.2022 at the earliest.

After such decision, the petitioner's case for promotion may again be

considered by the respondent department in accordance with law.

4. With the above direction, the claim petition is disposed of. No

order as to costs.
