## **JUDGEMENT**

Dated: 09th January, 2024

## Justice U.C. Dhyani (Oral)

By means of present claim petition, "the petitioner prays that his seniority by way of review DPC be considered before 2018 (for the post 2011-12)."

2. On 08.12.2022, requisition was sent by the Secretary, Housing, Govt. of Uttarakhand to the Public Service Commission asking for review of the DPC for the post of Assistant Engineer in Awas Vibhag, Govt. of Uttarakhand. Pursuant to the requisition received by Public Service Commission, the latter sent certain queries to be answered by Secretary, Housing, Govt. of Uttarakhand. The petitioner is aggrieved by the way in which Secretary, Housing, Govt. of Uttarakhand, has replied to such queries, as the same reflects further delay in the matter of reviewing the DPC. Complete facts are given in the claim petition. Such facts are part of record.

3. Documents have been filed by the petitioner in support of

his claim petition.

4. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the

petitioner will make a representation to respondent no. 2, who

should be directed to decide the representation and consider the

prayer of the petitioner for redressal of his grievances, in

accordance with law. It is also the submission of learned Counsel

for the petitioner that there are 13 vacant posts of Executive

Engineer and the petitioner be considered for such post. Learned

Counsel for the petitioner further submitted that till such time the

petitioner is considered for such post, vacant 13 posts may not be

filled up by the respondents in any manner. Learned Counsel for

the petitioner also submitted that there is urgency in the matter.

5. Learned A.P.O. has no objection to the innocuous prayer

of learned Counsel for the petitioner that a direction may be given

by the Tribunal to respondent no. 2 to decide the representation of

the petitioner, in accordance with law.

6. Learned Counsel for the parties submitted that such an

order can be passed by Single Bench of the Tribunal.

7. Without prejudice to the rival contentions, the Claim

Petition is disposed of, at the admission stage, with the consent of

learned Counsel for the parties, by directing respondent no. 2 to

decide the representation of the petitioner to ventilate his

grievance and consider his prayer, by a reasoned and speaking

order, in accordance with law, without unreasonable delay,

preferably within 10 weeks of presentation of certified copy of this

order along with representation enclosing the documents in

support thereof. No order as to costs.
