The petitioner has filed this claim petition for the following reliefs:

- i) To issue order or direction, directing the respondents to promote the applicant as Principal, Junior High School, as the juniors of the applicant have already been promoted to same, bypassing the seniority of applicant.
- ii) To issue any other order or direction, which this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.
- iii) To award the cost of the petition in favour of the applicant.

2. During course of arguments, learned Counsel for the

petitioner submitted that the petitioner is not claiming seniority with

already promoted Principals (Junior High School), but he is seeking

parity with the promoted Principals at Sl. No. 1162, 1166 and 1168.

After hearing to some length, learned Counsel for the petitioner

confined his prayer to the extent that he will file fresh representation

to the authorities concerned, which may kindly be directed to be

decided by the Respondent authorities within a stipulated time by

reasoned and speaking order, as per law.

3. Learned A.P.O. has no objection to the innocuous prayer made

by learned Counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the above, the petitioner shall move a fresh

representation to the Respondents within 30 days and the

respondent authority(s) shall decide the representation of the

petitioner by a reasoned and speaking order, as per law, within a

period of three months from the date of presentation of certified copy

of this order along with fresh representation.

5. Accordingly, the claim petition is disposed off. No order as to

costs.
