**JUDGEMENT**

**Dated: 11<sup>th</sup> February, 2025**

**Justice U.C. Dhyani (Oral)**

Present execution application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner along with affidavit and relevant document for securing compliance of directions contained in paras 22 to 25 of the judgement dated 04.06.2024, by respondents no. 3 and 4.

2. Copy of the judgement dated 04.06.2024 has been brought on record by the petitioner-applicant as Annexure: E1.

3. Copy of application, which has been addressed to the Executive Engineer, Provincial Division, PWD, on 30.06.2024 has been filed as Annexure: E2.

4. Certain information were obtained by the petitioner under RTI. The information thus obtained have also been filed with the execution application.

5. Sri L.D. Dobhal, learned Counsel for the petitioner-applicant pointed out an anomaly in documents enclosed with Annexure:E7 to submit that the share of Ms. Pushpa Tyagi (spouse) in documents thus filed with Annexure:E7 has been shown as '0' and share of Sri Deepak Tyagi (son) has been shown as '100'.

6. According to Sri Dobhal, the share of Ms. Puspa Tyagi (spouse) should be shown as 100% till she is alive and the share of Sri Deepak Tyagi (son) should be shown as 0%.

7. Sri V.P. Devrani, learned A.P.O., on seeking instructions from Sri Hansraj Chamoli, Administrative Officer, Provincial Division, PWD, Uttarakhand, submitted that the mistake committed in the documents enclosed with Annexure:E7 shall be corrected on receiving the copy of the order of the Tribunal. In other words, Sri Hansraj Chamoli, Administrative Officer, assured learned A.P.O./ Bench that the share of Ms. Pushpa Tyagi (spouse) shall be shown '100% till life' and the share of Sri Deepak Tyagi (son) shall be shown as '0%'. Sri Deepak Tyagi will be entitled to 100% share only on the death of his mother, Ms. Pushpa Tyagi.

8. The Tribunal takes note of the statement of the representative of the respondent department. A direction is given to respondent department to do the needful within four weeks.

9. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the present execution application pending. The same is, accordingly, closed. Liberty is given to Sri Dobhal to make a mention if the order of the Tribunal is not complied with within four weeks of presentation of certified copy of the order before the authority concerned.
