# Justice U.C.Dhyani (Oral)

- 1. The reliefs sought by the petitioner, in present claim petition, are as follows:-
  - (i) To issue an order or direction to the respondent No.3 to modify the impugned order dated 05.05.2015 (Annexure No. A-1 to the petition) and reinstate the petitioner in his service since 03.07.2009, the date when the petitioner was terminated from his service, with continuity of service.

(ii) To issue an order or direction to the concerned

respondents to fix the salary of the petitioner as was given to

the counterparts of batch 2009 of the petitioner along with

all service benefits including seniority, promotion etc. as per

direction of the Hon'ble High Court passed in the judgment

dated 13.09.2001 of W.P. No. 792/2009 (S/S).

(iii) Issue any other suitable order or direction which this

Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the

circumstances of the case.

(iv) To award the cost of the petition to the petitioner ."

2. Ld. Counsel for the parties pointed out that the reliefs, as claimed

for by the petitioner, in present claim petition, have been granted

by Respondent No.3. The same has been indicated in the last

paragraph of order dated 21.01.2018, passed by Sr. Superintendent

of Police, Pauri Garhwal. The said order has been enclosed as

Annexure: A 1 to the C.A. filed on behalf of respondents. Today,

Ld. A.P.O. has placed a copy of order passed by Superintendent of

Police, Chamoli on 21.02.2018 in this regard. Petitioner is satisfied

with the same.

3. Since, the desired reliefs, as claimed for by the petitioner in the

present claim petition, have been granted to him by the respondents,

therefore, the very purpose of filing the same has been achieved.

4. The claim petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
