Claim petition No. 02/SB/2015 was decided by this Tribunal *vide* order dated 17.08.2016 as follows:

“For the reasons stated above, the respondents are directed to re-consider the matter. For this purpose, the petitioner is allowed to give a representation afresh to respondent no.1 with all necessary details in respect of each bill for which according to him the payment has not been made within 15 days of the receipt of the certified copy of this order. Respondent No.1 is directed to decide the representation of the petitioner as per rules after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner within 3 months from the date of receipt of the representation.”

Compliance report has been filed on behalf of respondents to show that the order sought to be executed, has been complied with. A copy of Office Memorandum dated 19.03.2018, issued by the Joint Secretary, Agriculture has been brought on record to show the same.

It is the submission of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that the payment of bills has not been made to the petitioner as yet, although there is a letter of Joint Secretary in the Agriculture Department that as soon as the budget is allocated to the department, the payment of bills of the petitioner shall be made to him.

The execution application is, accordingly, closed with liberty to the petitioner to move for reopening of the execution application, purely in the interest of justice, if money is not paid to him, within a further period of eight weeks.
