JUDGMENT

Per: Justice U.C.Dhyani

By means of present claim petition, petitioner seeks following reliefs:

“(a) To issue appropriate order or direction, directing the respondent no.2 to decide the representation dated 20.09.2019 of the petitioner .

(b) To issue any other further order or direction which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case in favour of the petitioner.”

2. Facts of the claim petition have been narrated by the petitioner in Para No. 4 of the claim petition. He had moved representation on 20.09.2019 (Annexure: A1) to Respondent No.2, which representation is still lying pending with Respondent No.2 and has not been decided so far.
3. After arguing the claim petition at some length, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to the extent that his representation dated 20.09.2019 (Annexure: A 1) may kindly be directed to be decided by Respondent No. 2, by a speaking and reasoned order, at an earliest possible, in accordance with law, to which Ld. A.P.O. has no objection.
4. Considering the facts of the case, we think that Respondent No. 2 should be directed to decide the pending representation of the petitioner, as per law.
5. Respondent No.2 is directed to decide the pending representation dated 20.09.2019 (Copy Annexure: A 1),of the petitioner, by a reasoned and speaking order, in accordance with law, at an earliest possible, but not later than eight weeks of presentation of certified copy of this order along with copy of the representation.
6. The claim petition is, accordingly, disposed of, at the admission stage itself. No order as to costs.
