Petitioners have filed this petition to seek an order or direction for quashing the inter-departmental correspondences vide letters dated 25.06.2020, by which the department has sought C.R. of some officers. Petitioners have come up with the case that the respondents have not sought the C.Rs. of the petitioners, hence, they apprehend that they will not be included in the promotional exercise. Earlier, the respondents had argued in another petition before the Court that they will consider the promotion of the petitioners as well as other parties. The respondents are now adopting discriminatory attitude hence, they have approached this court.

Learned A.P.O. on behalf of the State has opposed this petition on the ground that the petitioners have challenged the inter-departmental correspondence and no cause of action has arisen to them. He has also submitted that if the incomplete records of the persons are being completed at the departmental level, it gives no cause of action to the petitioners and their petition is premature for admission.

After hearing both the sides, this court finds that the petition is premature. Simply, on the basis of inter-departmental correspondence, no cause of action has arisen to the petitioners, as none of their right has been infringed till now.

Finding the claim petition premature, it is not admitted and is decided accordingly.
